8th Grade Elitches Trip (**Repeated Information**)

Elitch Gardens Trip May 22nd Century Middle School will be taking our eighth graders on a field trip to Elitch Gardens on Monday, May 22nd to celebrate the successful completion of their middle school years.

We will be leaving school at 9:00 a.m. and plan to return to school by 5:00 p.m. – traffic permitting. There will be no bus service to take students home from school. Students should have rides arranged in advance.

If you need to pick your student up from Elitches at an earlier time you will be able to do so, only if your child checks out with a chaperone and we have advance notice in writing by May 8. Students leaving from Elitch Gardens must be picked up by a parent or legal guardian with appropriate identification.

Students are encouraged to bring money to purchase lunch while at Elitch Gardens. In addition, coolers will be provided for students to bring a sack lunch if they prefer. Please note that all sack lunches must be well labeled, packed in a disposable container, and should fit reasonably in a cooler; any leftover lunches that are not claimed at the end of the field trip will be thrown away. Elitch Gardens does not permit outside food inside the park, therefore students will have to be escorted out of the park by a teacher for lunch.

For re-entry, students must have their ticket stub and get their hand stamped before exiting the park.

- Students will not be allowed to participate in the Elitch Gardens field trip if they have received an out of school suspension after January 15th or have received a grade of 2 or less in two or more classes.
- Students will not be allowed to participate in the Elitch Gardens field trip if they have any library books lost or overdue or library fines as of May 12
- Permission forms will come home closer to the date.
- Teachers will not be at Century Middle School after 5:30 p.m. to supervise students. Please make sure to arrange for your student to get home safely upon return from Elitches.
