Materials

- School chromebook, charger (if needed), and headphones
- Journal (a composition book or one-subject spiral) (kept in classroom)
- Loose leaf notebook paper
- Highlighters (preferably multiple colors)
- Pencil or pen
- Book of your choice (need this EVERY DAY)

Expectations

- Come to class prepared and ready to work--start the moment you walk in.
- Phone is out of sight and may only be used with teacher permission.
- Sit in your assigned seat.
- Have all materials with you.
- Turn in work on time.
 - If there is a circumstance where you can't, this **MUST** be communicated with Mrs. Aylor beforehand and NOT at the last minute.

Classroom Routine

- Students will be seated immediately and write down the day's learning objective in his/her journal.
- Below the objective, students will begin the warm-up.
- There will be a mini lesson (usually around 15 min. or so) of direct instruction.
- Students will have work time on a specific task tied to the mini lesson.
- Class will close with some form of reflection or exit ticket.

Late work policy

- Late formative assessments will be graded once current work is graded, as current work is the priority.
- Summative assessments –
 - Students have two weeks from the day graded assignments are returned/grades entered into Infinite Campus to make up work (per student handbook).
 - If needed, please talk to Mrs. Aylor within the time period to discuss extensions or exceptions.

Leaving the classroom

- Passes will be given to students from the teacher.

Use technology in class appropriately

- NO playing games on chromebooks.
- NO using phones for anything other than to assist with the learning for that day or if listening to music is permitted (This is teacher discretion).
- Failing at any of this will result in a loss of classroom privilege

Classroom Considerations

- No food or drink, other than water.
- Ask three before me for any questions or clarifications you may have.
 - Three other people in the classroom before you ask Mrs. Aylor.
- Do not ask to go to the bathroom in the middle of a lesson. (Instead, ask at an appropriate, non disruptive time.)
- Do not talk/interrupt when someone else is speaking.
 - Be respectful of/to your teacher and classmates.

At the end of the day, the most important thing to remember is that we are all here with the same goal in mind: to end the day a better person than we started. We should always strive for excellence in everything we do, approach situations with an open mind, and treat others with the respect we would want them to treat us with.
